WHEREAS, the Fédération Internationale des Échecs (FIDE) or World Chess Federation is an international organization that connects the various national chess federations around the world and acts as the governing body of international chess competition;

WHEREAS, Alekhine F. Nouri, a resident of Barangay Pasong Tamo, Quezon City, is an international chess player who began playing competitive chess at the age of five (5), and began joining international chess competitions at the age of six (6);


WHEREAS, Alekhine F. Nouri is a grantee of athletic scholar from Far Eastern University-Diliman, Quezon City, receives allowance from Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) as member of the Philippine Chess Team, and is now gearing up for his next goal of International Master, a title one step shy of the prestigious Grand Master title;

WHEREAS, Alekhine F. Nouri recently won several international chess tournaments namely: 2014 U.S. Class Championship, 2014 Reno Western States Open Chess Tournament, 2014 North California Blitz Championships, 2014 Antelope Valley 1st Winter Open Chess Tournament, 2014 North American Open chess tournament, 2015 Kota Kinabalu Open Under 12 Class, and 2015 Langkawi Open Under 12 Class;

WHEREAS, during the 14th Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Age Group Chess Championships 2013 in Thailand, Alekhine F. Nouri claimed an outright FIDE Master title with his victory in the Open 8-under category, thus making him as the youngest Filipino FIDE Master and the current youngest FIDE Master in the world at the age of seven (7);

WHEREAS, Alekhine F. Nouri is indeed one of the elite chess players in the country, and being groomed as the youngest International Grand Master in the world by the age of twelve (12). Hence, he is worthy to be acknowledged so that young people could emulate his deeds and achievements.






