RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6415** , S-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) WITH COMMAND AND CONTROL CENTER EQUIPMENT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF EIGHTY NINE MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTEEN PESOS AND FORTY CENTAVOS (PHP89,253,718.40) TO BE INSTALLED IN AND UTILIZED BY ALL THE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN QUEZON CITY, TO BE CHARGED FROM THE LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION (SPECIAL ACTIVITIES PROGRAM).

WHEREAS, the safety and security of the City's children is the responsibility of the school once they step foot on school grounds;

WHEREAS, closed-circuit television (CCTV) or video surveillance, a tool commonly used for safety and security purposes, can be effectively utilized to monitor those who visit the schools, track unacceptable student behavior, and maintain a record of evidence for crime;

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor is requesting for authorization from the Quezon City Council to enter into a contract/agreement for the purchase of CCTVs with command and control center equipment in the total amount of Eighty Nine Million Two Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighteen Pesos and Forty Centavos (Php89,253,718.40);

WHEREAS, the CCTVs and their accompanying equipment will be installed in the 16 large, 81 medium, and 45 small public elementary and secondary schools in the City;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a contract/agreement for the purchase of CCTVs with command and control center equipment in the total amount of Eighty Nine Million Two Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighteen Pesos and Forty Centavos (Php89,253,718.40) to be installed in and utilized by all the public elementary and secondary schools in Quezon City, to be charged from the lump sum appropriation (Special Activities Program).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Local School Board, City Budget Department, City Accounting Department, Commission on Audit-Quezon City Field Office, Department of the Interior and Local Government, for their information and guidance.
