RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6458 _, S-2015

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, AND THE THIRTY THREE (33) STALL HOLDERS OF THE QUEZON MEMORIAL CIRCLE.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has already and directly undertaken the further development, including the actual administration, management and over-all maintenance of the Quezon Memorial Circle;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is the owner of a parcel of land with an approximate area of twenty six (26) hectares known as the Quezon Memorial Circle and intends to use a portion thereof for the construction and operation of Plant Stalls selling varied plant species, tree saplings, plant pots/boxes, seedlings, garden paraphernalia and/or other allied products/items to park-goers under the terms and condition acceptable to both parties;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (l) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the ratification of the Memorandum of Agreements entered into by and between the Quezon City Government and various Quezon Memorial Circle stall holders is imperative.
