RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6485** , S-2015

*A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CONTRACTS OR AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO BY THE HONORABLE MAYOR OF QUEZON CITY WITH THE WINNING BIDDERS CONTRACTORS FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES UNDERTAKEN BY THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT (GSD) OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.*

*WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units (LGUs) shall be made through competitive public bidding;*

*WHEREAS, Sections 22 (c) and 455 (vi) of the same Code requires the prior authorization of the City Council before the Local Chief Executive can enter into a contract on behalf of the local government unit;*

*WHEREAS, Resolution No. SP-6305, S-2015 authorizes the Honorable City Mayor to enter into a contract with the winning bidder contractor for the provision of security services undertaken by the City General Services Department of the Quezon City Government;*

*WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the same Code likewise provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;*

WHEREAS, Section 25 of Ordinance No. SP-2345, S-2014, otherwise known as the General Appropriations Ordinance of Quezon City provides that all bonds, contracts, obligations and such other documents which the City Mayor, upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, may have signed or executed in representation of the city, shall be confirmed and ratified through a separate resolution or ordinance enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod. For this purpose, the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall be provided with a copy of the contract/s to be ratified;


