WHEREAS, one of our indigenous sports, arnis de mano, has been adopted as our National Sports through Republic Act No. 9850 aptly entitled "An Act Declaring Arnis de Mano as the National Martial Arts and Sports of the Philippines". WHEREAS, these indigenous sports should be included in Physical Education classes to teach students the importance of these sports to our national history and culture and the rudiments of the sports to Filipino students.
