A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. SP-1922. S-2009. NO. IMPLEMENT ORDINANCE BAUTISTA. TOOTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. ORDINANCE *MANDATING* S-2004 'AN ENTITLED CONSTRUCTION OF A CITY GOVERNMENT-OWNED CREMATORIUM IN AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION TO BE DETERMINED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, DIRECTING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ENGINEER OF THIS CITY TO PREPARE THE PLANS AND COST ESTIMATES THEREFOR AND APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS."

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution No. SP-2812, S-2005, entitled "A Resolution Urging the Honorable Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to Allocate Funds for the Construction of a Government-Owned Crematorium in an Appropriate Place in Quezon City, the Fund to be Taken from the Infrastructure Fund or Any Available Fund of the City Treasury", on March 1, 2005;

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Ordinance No. SP-1922, S-2009, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. SP-1400, S-2004 entitled 'An Ordinance Mandating the Construction of a City Government-Owned Crematorium in an Appropriate Location to be Determined by the Quezon City Government, Directing the Office of the City Engineer of this City to Prepare the Plans and Cost Estimates Therefor and Appropriating Necessary Funds Therefor" on April 23, 2009;

WHEREAS, Councilor Eufemio C. Lagumbay has proposed a resolution, PR19CC-918, entitled "Resolution Urging the Honorable Mayor Herbert M. Bautista to Consider Constructing a City-Owned and-Operated Crematorium", on March 19, 2015;

WHEREAS, the high cost of funeral services has reached a point where it is now beyond the capacity of the urban poor sector of Quezon City to provide a decent burial for their demised family member, thus, resorting to solicitation as a solution to their inadequacy;

WHEREAS, the public cemeteries in Bagbag, Baesa, Novaliches, and La Loma are now overcrowded, thus, forcing our urban poor constituents to bury their demised family members elsewhere at a higher cost;

WHEREAS, the construction of a City Government-owned and operated crematorium will serve to partially answer their woes.
