**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO UTILIZE THE SOCIALIZED HOUSING FUND AND DIAMOND JUBILEE FUND OF THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SERVICES, MATERIALS, AND DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX TO BE USED BY THE SECRETARY TO THE MAYOR AND TASK FORCE ON SOCIALIZED HOUSING AND DEVELOPMENT ON BLIGHTED AREAS.**

*WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units (LGUs) shall be made through competitive public bidding;*

*WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the same Code provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;*


*WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C (2013), citing as basis the Supreme Court decision in the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses or disbursements will be charged against a budget lump sum appropriation;*

NOW, THEREFORE,


