*WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Quezon City government to recognize outstanding achievements in vital fields like education, sports, arts, culture, and the like;*

*WHEREAS, the 1<sup>st</sup> Singapore International Mathematics Olympiad Challenge (SIMOC) was held at Singapore last August 14 to 17, 2015, which drew 338 participants from the following countries and territories: Bulgaria, Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Uzbekistan and Vietnam;*

*WHEREAS, this 1st SIMOC 2015 is organized by the same group of education specialists who structured the Singapore And Asian Schools Math Olympiad (SASMO), one of the largest Math Olympiads in the Asian region for the past 10 years;*

*WHEREAS, the Philippine team bagged 14 gold medals, 20 silver medals, 29 bronze medals and 11 honorable mention awards in this international competition, wherein 2 gold medals, 2 bronze medals and 2 honorable mention awards were reaped by the representatives from the schools in Quezon City;*




*WHEREAS, Mr. John Jeffrey R. Bo, a 14-year-old Grade 8 student of Novaliches High School, brought home one of the Bronze Medal awards and is the lone winner who hails from a Quezon City Government-run school;*

*WHEREAS, Mr. John Jeffrey R. Bo's family is one of the beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) of Quezon City bearing Household No. 137404043-10266-00018 SET 7E;*

*WHEREAS, being one of the poorest of the poor did not prevent Mr. John Jeffrey R. Bo to pursue his studies and stand out as one of the Math wizards of the Philippines.*
