WHEREAS, the Quezon City Judo Team joined the 2015 Philippine Youth Games, more popularly known as "Batang Pinoy," held at the Malolos Sports Arena on July 17-22, 2015;

WHEREAS, "Batang Pinoy" is organized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) in cooperation with the Philippine Olympic Committee (POC) in connection with their youth development programs;

WHEREAS, "Batang Pinoy" as an integral part of the national policy and program for sports development effectively addresses the need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and play;

WHEREAS, the Batang Pinoy Judo Tournament is one of the eight (8) martial arts events which were showcased in this year's youth games;


WHEREAS, the members of the Quezon City Judo Team who won the tournament are as follows:


