RESOLUTION NO. SP-	6575	, S-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS (P33,557,000.00) TO THE MUNICIPALITIES IN REGIONS II AND III OF NORTHERN LUZON SEVERELY AFFECTED BY TYPHOON LANDO (KOPPU) NAMELY: SAN MIGUEL, BULACAN; BALER, AURORA; AND BAMBANG, NUEVA VIZCAYA TO BE TAKEN FROM THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, Typhoon "Lando" with International Name "Koppu", a category-four storm, with sustained winds of 130 kph and gustiness of 160 kph, entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) in the afternoon of 14 October 2015 and has made landfall at 1:00 a.m. of 18 October 2015 passed through Luzon Island. Lando is considered to be the strongest typhoon to land in Luzon in five years;

WHEREAS, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Situational Report No. 25 (Effects of Typhoon Lando), dated 1 November 2015 disclosed that a total of 733,152 families or 3,126,127 persons were affected in Regions I, II. III, IV-A, V, NCR, and CAR;

WHEREAS, NDRRMC Situational Report No. 25 reported that the total estimated cost of damages to agriculture and infrastructure in Regions I, II, III, V, and CAR pegged at P11,000,003,194.04;

WHEREAS, the same report states that: 16,349 families or 83,985 persons were affected in Sam Miguel, Bulacan; 4,049 families or 16,912 persons in Baler, Aurora; and 1,081 families or 5,407 in Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya;

WHEREAS, the Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MMDRRMC) approved on 21 October 2015 MMDRRMC Resolution No. 2 "Resolution Adopting Worst Hit Local Government Units (LGUs) by Typhoon Lando";

WHEREAS, a disaster of this magnitude requires these affected LGUs all the needed assistance, support and help for their relief and recovery operations;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the MMDRRMC Resolution, the Quezon City Government, upon the recommendation of the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, committed to grant assistance amounting to P33,557,000.00 to the identified Typhoon Lando worst hit municipalities of San Miguel, Bulacan, Baler, Aurora, and Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya. The amount shall be proportioned based on the needs of the said LGUs and shall be divided as follows:

LGU	AMOUNT	INTENDED USE
San Miguel, Bulacan	P28,111,000.00	Rehabilitation of farm to market roads
Baler, Aurora	P1,600,000.00	Agricultural assistance such as seeds & Fertilizer Fishing boats for livelihood Infrastructure rehabilitation
Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya	P3,846,000.00	Rehabilitation of irrigation system Provision of rescue equipment and other tools

WHEREAS, Rule 18, Section 1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10121 (the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010) provides that upon the recommendation of the LDPPMC and approval of the Sanggunian concerned, the LDRRMC may transfer the said fund to support the disaster risk reduction of other LDRRMCs which are declared under state of calamity.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to extend financial assistance in behalf of the Quezon City government in the amount of Thirty Three Million Five Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand Pesos (P33,557,000.00) to the municipalities in Regions II and III of Northern Luzon severely affected by Typhoon Lando (Koppu) namely: San Miguel, Bulacan; Baler, Aurora; and Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya to be taken from the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund.
