WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council, on several occasions, has recognized Barangays for their outstanding achievements and contributions to aggressively scale up interventions aimed at elevating the practice of good governance not only at the city level, but more importantly, at the Barangay level;

WHEREAS, in response to the national government's call for good governance, the Quezon City administration is pushing for participatory governance focusing on deepening democratic engagement through the participation of citizens in the processes of governance with the City Government;

WHEREAS, in a bid to be responsive to this kind of engagement and further the efforts toward public accountability and transparency, the Seal of Good Housekeeping was implemented in all 142 barangays of the City; X

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Barangay Seal of Good Housekeeping is a collaborative project of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Quezon City government which primarily aims to give primacy to the principle of effective performance, accountability, transparency, and citizens' participation in local governance;


WHEREAS, the Seal will be awarded to Barangays that perform well in their internal housekeeping, such as local legislation (paggawa ng batas), development planning (pagplano para sa kaunlaran), resource allocation and utilization (paglalaan at paggamit ng kaban ng bayan), service delivery (paghatid ng serbisyo), community engagement (paghikayat sa komunidad), and human resource management (pagangasiwa ng yamang tao);

WHEREAS, Barangay Mangga of the Third District of Quezon City is one of the recipients of the barangays with Most Functional Barangay Based Institutions (BBIS), a Special Award of the Seal of Good Housekeeping.


