RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6608**, S-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE WINNING BIDDERS/CONTRACTORS FOR THE PROVISION OF GOODS AND SUPPLIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE OFFICE OF THE VICE MAYOR IN THE AMOUNT OF ELEVEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY NINE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 11,529,000.00).

WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units shall be through public bidding;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the same Code provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and shall sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, or pursuant to law or ordinance; †

WHEREAS, pursuant to the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing v Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R No. 175527), the Supreme Court requires the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursement charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made;

WHEREAS, Section 24 of City Ordinance No. SP-2345, S-2014, otherwise known as the General Appropriations Ordinance of Quezon City provides that other contracts whose amount is duly appropriated as Lump Sum Appropriations or for Special Activities, shall require a Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution granting the City Mayor authority to enter into and sign such contracts;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Vice Mayor is requesting for a City Council Resolution for the purchase of goods to be distributed to Quezon City constituents specifically described as follows:
