RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6624**, S-2015

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A CONTRACT OF AGREEMENT WITH THE WINNING BIDDER/CONTRACTOR OF SERVICES AND SUPPLIES FOR THE "DANCING CHRISTMAS VILLAGE" PROJECT, DEDICATED SPECIFICALLY FOR THE YULETIDE SEASON."**

*WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160 mandates that "the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units shall be made through competitive public bidding";*

*WHEREAS, Section 455 (b), (i) (vi) of R. A. No. 7160 states that, "The City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";*

*WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C, S-2013, "requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursements charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made" citing the Supreme Court case of Hon. Gabriel Quisimbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527) as basis;*

WHEREAS, the local government of Quezon City joins the nation in celebrating the Yuletide season, and in connection thereto, the City is conducting various programs and projects dedicated for its residents and guests;

WHEREAS, the celebration of the Yuletide season would entail the use of the following supplies and services: 1) Events Management; 2) Public Celebration supplies and materials; 3) Services; and 4) Lease and Rental;

WHEREAS, there exists an Approved Budget of the Contracts that is already available/chargeable against the funds of the Office of the Mayor, as certified by the Budget Department:


WHEREAS, the "Dancing Christmas Village" Project shall require the necessary supplies, equipments and manpower, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Bautista, to enter into and sign a contract of agreement with the winning bidder/contractor of services and supplies for the "Dancing Christmas Village" project, dedicated specifically for the yuletide season." 


