

WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units (LGUs) shall be made through competitive public bidding;

WHEREAS, Sections 22 (c) and 455 (vi) of the said Code requires the prior authorization of the City Council before the local Chief Executive can enter into a contract on behalf of the local government unit;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (l) (vi) of the same Act also provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, or pursuant to a law or ordinance;
