A RESOLUTION DONATING TWENTY TWO (22) UNITS OF COMPUTER SETS AS PART OF THE EDUCATION ENHANCEMENT CAMPAIGN OF QUEZON CITY, WHICH WERE PURCHASED THROUGH THE FUNDS OF COUNCILOR DOROTHY A. DELARMENTE, TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO TEN (10) PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS, EIGHT (8) PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS AND FOUR (4) BARANGAYS IN DISTRICT 1, QUEZON CITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE SAID COMPUTER SETS TO THE RECIPIENTS WITHOUT COST.

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to donate, as it does hereby donate twenty two (22) units of computer sets as part of Education Enhancement Campaign of Quezon City which were purchased through the funds of Councilor Dorothy A. Delarmente to be distributed to Ten (10) Public Elementary Schools, Eight (8) Public High Schools, and Four (4) Barangays in District 1, Quezon City, and authorizing the transfer of ownership of said computer sets to the recipients without cost.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the ownership of the said computer sets be transferred to the recipients through a Deed of Donation to be signed by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, Councilor Dorothy A. Delarmente and the Head of the City General Services Department (CGSD), Mr. Rolando P. Montiel.
