WHEREAS, the late German Moreno started as a utility worker at the once popular Clover Theater in Manila in the 1950s. He became a stage actor, and later a film star;

WHEREAS, also known as Kuya Germs or the Master Showman, was a Filipino television host, actor, comedian and talent manager;

WHEREAS, Kuya Germs has been credited with developing and producing some of the country's biggest stars through his former TV show 'That's Entertainment and also the host of the popular TV show "Walang Tulugan";

WHEREAS, the late German Moreno is the founder of the Eastwood City Walk Of Fame in Quezon City, which is the local counterpart of the "Walk of Fame" in Hollywood, USA, to recognize artists, broadcasters, singers and others who made significant contributions to the showbiz industry;


WHEREAS, on January 8, 2016, German Moreno died from cardiac arrest at the age 82.

NOW, THEREFORE,


