RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6731**, S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO UTILIZE THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND OF THE QUEZON CITY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) SET OF MULTI-STATION WITH REFLECTORLESS ELECTRONIC DISTANCE MEASUREMENT (EDM) (R2000) AND HIGH SPEED 1000HZ ELECTRONIC DISTANCE MEASUREMENT (EDM) IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP15,830,000.00), TO BE USED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS).

WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by the Local Government Units (LGUs) shall be made through competitive public bidding;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of the same Code provides that the City Mayor, as the chief executive of the city government, shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, or pursuant to law or ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit issued Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C (2013), citing as basis the Supreme Court decision in the case of Honorable Gabriel Quisumbing vs. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses or disbursements will be charged against a budget lump sum appropriation; ↗


WHEREAS, Gen. Elmo DG. San Diego, Ph. D, Head of the Department of Public Order and Safety and Action Officer of Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (QCDRRMC), is requesting the Quezon City Council for authority to purchase the following item, specifically described as follows:

Bautista, to utilize the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the Quezon City Appropriation Ordinance for the purchase of one (1) set of multi-station with Reflectorless Electronic Distance Measurement (EDM) (R2000) and high speed 1000Hz Electronic Distance Measurement (EDM) in the total amount of Fifteen Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Pesos (PHP15,830,000.00), to be used by the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS).

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Bids and Awards Committee and the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) be furnished with this Resolution.
