A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO VIRON TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION, INC. FOR THE OPERATION OF BUS TERMINAL LOCATED AT NO. 697 EPIFANIO DELOS SANTOS AVENUE (EDSA) BARANGAY IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, WITH PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND GARAGE AT NO. 1360 BLUMENTRITT STREET CORNER MARIA CLARA STREET, BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO LABRADOR, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Viron Transporation Corporation, Inc. with principal office and garage at No. 1360 Blumentritt Street corner Maria Clara Street, Barangay San Isidro Labrador, Quezon City, is applying for a Special Use Permit for the operation of a bus terminal located at No. 697 EDSA, Barangay Immaculate Conception, District 4, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Article VII, Section 2 and Article IX of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, a Special Use Permit is required for this project;

WHEREAS, the petitioner has complied with all the prescribed requirements relative to the issuance of a Special Use Permit.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the issuance of a Special Use Permit to Viron Transportation Corporation, Inc. for the operation of a bus terminal located at No. 697 Epifanio Delos Santos Avenue (EDSA), Barangay Immaculate Conception, District IV, Quezon City, with principal office and garage at No. 1360 Blumentritt Street corner Maria Clara Street, Barangay San Isidro Labrador, Quezon City.
