RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6743**, S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF EMERGENCY RESCUE MOTOR VEHICLE INTENDED FOR THE QUICK RESPONSE DURING NATURAL DISASTERS/CALAMITIES AND OTHER EMERGENCIES WITHIN DISTRICT IV, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED TWELVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED PESOS (PHP1,112,600.00.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY.


