RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6759**, S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE OFFICE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT FOR THE LEASE OF THE QUEZON CITY RECEPTION HOUSE LOCATED AT NO. 100 11TH STREET, NEW MANILA, BARANGAY MARIANA, QUEZON CITY COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE (TCT) NUMBERED N-305262 WITH A TOTAL LAND AREA OF FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY TWO SQUARE METERS (5,192 SQ.M.) MORE OR LESS, AS THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION (NCR) OFFICE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT.

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*WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City Mayor to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance as may be found in Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;*

WHEREAS, the National Board of Canvassers (NBOC) composed of representatives of both the House and the Senate proclaimed Maria Leonor "Leni" Robredo as the Vice President-elect of the Republic of the Philippines, having topped the official congressional count of the 2016 elections;

WHEREAS, the Vice President-elect has expressed her earnest desire to hold her honor's proposed NCR office in the locality of Quezon City where many national government agencies and non-government organizations' associated with her advocacies are located;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Reception House, with a floor area of One Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Square Meters and Four Square Decimeters (1,850.04 sq. m.), originally built to be a satellite office of the Mayor of Quezon City and where ceremonial and diplomatic functions could be carried out, was identified by the Office of the Vice President as a potential site.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to negotiate and enter into contract with the Office of the Vice President for the use of the Quezon City Reception House located at No. 100 11th Street, New Manila, Barangay Mariana, Quezon City, covered by Transfer of Certificates of Title (TCT) Number N-305262 and N-208116 with gross area of Seven Thousand One Hundred Forty Five Square Meters (7,145 sq.m), more or less, as the National Capital Region (NCR) Office of the Vice President.




