WHEREAS, the Southeast Asian Games (also known as the SEA Games), is a biennial multi-sport event involving participants from the current 11 countries of Southeast Asia including the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the games was held from 5 to 16 June 2015, although several events had commenced from 29 May 2015. About 4,370 athletes from 11 participated nations competed in the Games, with 402 events in 36 sports featured in the Games;

WHEREAS, fencing is a sport of fighting with swords, especially foils, épées, or sabers, according to a set of rules, in order to score points against an opponent:

WHEREAS, the sport of fencing incorporates agility, strength, coordination, balance, and timing. In fencing, physical ability is just as important as having a strong mental edge;

WHEREAS, in foil fencing, touches are scored with the tip of the blade. The target is the torso. Fencers wear a metallic vest, or lame, to register touches electronically. Beginners learn the foil method first because it is the most technical form of fencing to execute and requires the most legwork. The foil method also incorporates all the basic elements of fencing;

WHEREAS, Ms. Wilhelmina R. Lozada, or "Bing Bing" as she is called by her peers, a true native of Barangay Damayan and Quezon City's own and a member of the Philippine Team who competed and represented the Philippines, garnered bronze in the Women's Team Foil event;

WHEREAS, Wilhelmina started fencing in 2007 when she was only ten (10) years old and eventually demonstrated her skills and talent. Through her coach, Mr. Rolando Canlas, she achieved her dreams and garnered awards for the country;

WHEREAS, through determination, dedication and hard work, she made a distinguished contribution in the field of sports. She also mirrors the energy, enthusiasm and determination of today's athlete;

WHEREAS, the local government of Quezon City is truly proud and honored of the award and international recognition given to her, being a resident of Quezon City.
