WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital is now experiencing an increase number of patients being treated, consulted and admitted for the past four years:

WHEREAS, in order to meet the demand of the increasing number of patients, Quezon City General Hospital has applied with the Department of Health for the increase of bed capacity from 250-bed to 300-bed;

WHEREAS, as required by the Department of Health in granting a Level III, tertiary training hospital accreditation, the Quezon City General Hospital should be authorized by the City Council through a Resolution for such increase in bed capacity.
