RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6794 , S-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO APPROPRIATE AN AMOUNT OF TWENTY THREE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP23,200,000.00) FOR THE PROVISION OF FOOD FOR THE DETAINED OFFENDERS OF QUEZON CITY JAIL, QCJ-ANNEX AND QCJ-FED, COVERING THE PERIOD OF JANUARY TO DECEMBER 2016.


WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of the same Code provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf, all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, in the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing v Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R No. 175527), the Supreme Court requires the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expenses/disbursement charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Jail is requesting for a City Council Resolution for the purchase of food for the detained offenders of Quezon City Jail, QCJ-Annex and QCJ Fed. specifically described as follows:
