WHEREAS, Ms. Jaclyn Jose in real life is Mary Jane Sta. Ana Guck, a Filipino veteran actress in the TV and movie industry. She was born on March 16, 1964 in Angeles City, Pampanga, Philippines;

WHEREAS, Ms. Jose started her show business career in 1986 and is being remembered for her unforgettable roles in Filipino movies such as "Salome," "White Slavery," and "Santa Juana." She is a versatile actress who received numerous awards in local and international cinemas. She bagged the Best Actress in the Gawad Urian for the movies Takaw Tukso in 1987, Itanong mo sa Buwan in 1989, and Sarong Banggi in 2006, and Best Supporting Actress in the Film Academy of the Philippines (FAP) for the movie, Flor Contemplacion Story;

WHEREAS, Cannes Film Festival, is an annual film festival held in Cannes, France, which previews new films of all genres, including documentaries, from around the world. Founded in 1946, it is one of the most publicised, together with the Berlin International Film Festival and the Venice Film Festival. The invitation-only festival is held annually (usually in May) at the Palais des Festivals et des Congrès;

WHEREAS, last May 22, 2016 Jaclyn Jose had won the Best Actress Award in the 69th Cannes Film Festival for the film Ma' Rosa and having been the first ever Filipino and South-east Asian to receive such prestigious award;

WHEREAS, Ma' Rosa is a 2016 Filipino drama film directed by Brillante Mendoza, a story portraying a Mother forced to sell drugs in order to dispatch poverty. It was selected to compete for the Palme d'Or at the 2016 Cannes Film Festival, in which Ms. Jaclyn Jose won the award for Best Actress;

WHEREAS, it is right and just for the Quezon City Council to commend Ms. Jaclyn Jose for bringing honor and glory to our country.
