RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6803 , S-2016

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A SPECIAL PERMIT TO DEHADISTA GAMING INC. TO OPERATE A SPORTS BAR AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GAMES LOCATED AT NO. 19 WEST POINT STREET, BARANGAY E. RODRIGUEZ, CUBAO, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, Dehadista Gaming, Inc., a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office at No. 19 West Point Street, Barangay E. Rodriguez, Cubao, Quezon City, is applying for a special permit for the operation of sports bar and other electronic games;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) granted Dehadista Gaming, Inc. the authority to operate electronic games;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Council, through a Resolution, may grant Special Permits or licenses;

WHEREAS, Dehadista Gaming, Inc. is requesting the City Council to grant a Special Permit to operate a sports bar that includes the operation of a poker games, bingo boutique, E-games Station, Instawin Terminals and Megasports World Betting Station;

WHEREAS, Dehadista Gaming, Inc., through its representative Mr. Michael Mariano is applying for a special permit to operate a Sports Bar and other Electronic Games in Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant a Special Permit to Dehadista Gaming Inc., to operate a Sports Bar and other Electronic Games at No. 19 West Point Street, Barangay E. Rodriguez, Cubao, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that Dehadista Gaming, Inc. shall remit a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross sales of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the authority herein granted shall be for a period of two (2) years and maybe renewed by the City Council.
