WHEREAS, Carlos Edriel Yulo, known to his friends as "Caloy", 19 years old, exemplified his remarkable skills in the recently concluded 2019 World Artistic Gymnastic Championship held last November 2, 2018, 49th FIG Artistic Gymnastic World Championships Floor Exercise category at the Hans Martin Schyler Halle in Stuttgart, Germany, won the first gold medal for the Philippines;
