TFP enlist some of the country's most promising young leaders to teach for two (2) years in public schools throughout the Philippines. Through their experiences in the classroom, Teach for the Philippines transforms our leaders into lifelong advocates for education equity;

WHEREAS, TFP is focused on bridging the education gap in the Philippines by advocating functional literacy and progressive teacher and administrator training. The initiative is designed to recruit, select, train and provide on-going professional development to young individuals committed to closing the achievement gap by serving as Fellows in under-resourced school systems;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the TFP Program will: provide Fellows in the public elementary and high schools in Quezon City; continue the training program for education and non-education members to become successful and transformational teachers; and help in the research and development for future education policies;

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a Memorandum of Agreement be executed and entered into between Quezon City through the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, the Department of Education, Division of Quezon City through Dr. Jenilyn Rose B. Corpuz, Schools Division Superintendent and the Teach for the Philippines through Ms. Clarissa Isabelle L. Delgado, Chief Executive Officer, to show that the parties have accepted and mutually agreed in the Terms and Conditions set forth under the Memorandum of Agreement.

## NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with Teach for the Philippines, Inc., and the Department of Education, Division of Quezon City for SY 2019-2020, SY 2020-2021 and SY 2021-2022, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
