WHEREAS, the 2019 Novel Coronavirus, also known as the 2019-nCoV, is a contagious disease and currently a global concern because of its human-to-human transmission nature;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH), the Civil Aeronautics Board (CAB) and the Bureau of Immigration (BI) confirmed in news reports that numerous Chinese Nationals from Wuhan City, China, which is the epicenter of the outbreak, were able to enter the country because of its direct flights from Wuhan City to the Philippines;

WHEREAS, at present, due to the said virus, the death toll in China rose to at least 361 and there are confirmed cases in the United States, France, Canada, Finland, Germany, UAE, Australia, Japan, Republic of Korea, Vietnam, Nepal, Sri Lanka, India, Thailand, Malaysia, Cambodia, Singapore and other developing countries;
