RESOLUTION NO. SP. 8081 , S-2020

A RESOLUTION URGING THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA), THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO), AND THE HIGHWAY PATROL GROUP (HPG) OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) TO STRICTLY ENFORCE THE APPREHENSION OF ALL MOTOR VEHICLES TRAVERSING IN ALL PUBLIC ROADS DURING THE NIGHT TIME WITH A TURNED OFF, BUSTED OR NON-FUNCTIONING HEADLIGHTS, TAIL LIGHTS, SIGNAL LIGHTS, BRAKE LIGHTS, HAZARD LIGHTS AND OTHER AUTHORIZED VEHICLE LIGHTS.

WHEREAS, the use of headlights, tail lights, brake lights, hazard lights and other authorized vehicle lights by the drivers of motor vehicles traversing in all public roads during night time is mandated by law as a precautionary measure to prevent car or road accidents;

WHEREAS, it has been observed, for unknown reasons, many of the drivers of motor vehicles traversing in public roads during night time are not using their headlights and other authorized vehicle lights, particularly the public utility vehicles such as the jeepneys, taxi cabs, and buses;

WHEREAS, most of the road crash or accidents happens during the night time because of darkness, less visibility, and unnoticeable road signs and moving vehicles;

WHEREAS, to prevent the frequent occurrence of road crash/accidents, especially during night time, it is imperative for the drivers of motor vehicles to use their headlights and other authorized vehicle lights and keep the same in functioning condition while traveling or plying in public roads.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), the Land Transportation Office (LTO), and the Highway Patrol Group (HPG) of the Philippine National Police (PNP) to strictly enforce apprehension of all motor vehicles traversing in all public roads during the night time with a turned off, busted or non-functioning headlights, tail lights, signal lights, brake lights, hazard lights and other authorized vehicle lights.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Offices of the MMDA, LTO, and HPG of the PNP for their information and appropriate action.
