WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 773 mandates that one of the functions of the Peace and Order Council is to recommend measures which will enhance the peace and order and public safety in their area of responsibility;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, as the Chief Executive of the Local Government of Quezon City, signed Executive Order No. 34 series of 2019 entitled "Reconstituting the Quezon City Peace and Order Council (QCPOC) and Reaffirming with Modifications the Composition, Organization, Functions, and Funding Thereof";

mandates the Local Peace and Order Council to formulate its 3-year Development Plan for Peace known as the Local Peace and Order Public Safety Plan or the LPOPSP;

WHEREAS, the Peace and Order Public Safety Plan is a 3-year development plan formulated by the Local Peace and Order Councils which contains plans, programs and activities aimed to maintain and further enhance the peace and order situation and ensure public safety of their constituents;

WHEREAS, spearheaded by the QCPOC Technical Working Group, the QCPOC conducted its POPS Planning Workshop on September 24-25, 2019 where the group was divided into six (6) clusters patterned on the focus areas of POPS Plan;


WHEREAS, in the November 08, 2019 Quezon City Peace and Order Council meeting held at Bulwagang Amoranto, the 2020-2022 Peace and Order Public Safety Plan was duly adopted by the Council, through the QCPOC Resolution No. 06, Series of 2019;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Peace and Order Council Peace and Order Public Safety Plan Technical Working Group transmitted to the City Council a copy of the 2020-2022 QC POPS Plan for the necessary adoption, hence this Resolution.


NOW, THEREFORE,
