A RESOLUTION STRONGLY CONDEMNING ALL FORMS OF ATROCITIES AND ACTS OF VIOLENCE IN SUPPORT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 70, S-2018.

- i. The Philippines renounces war as an instrument of national policy;*
- ii. The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy; and*
- iii. The State shall promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard of living, and an improved quality of life for all.*

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 70 (E.O. No. 70), S-2018, otherwise known as Institutionalizing the Whole-Of-Nation Approach in Attaining Inclusive and Sustainable Peace, Creating a National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, and Directing the Adoption of a National Peace Framework is a government policy that provides inclusive and conflict-affected areas and vulnerable communities;


WHEREAS, the Whole-of-Nation approach addresses the root causes of insurgencies, internal disturbances and tensions, and other armed conflicts and threats by prioritizing and harmonizing the delivery of basic services and social development packages by the government, facilitating societal inclusivity, and ensuring active participation of all sectors of the society in the pursuit of the country's peace agenda;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), as mandated in Memorandum Circular No. 2019-200 entitled Declaration to condemn all forms of atrocities and acts of violence enjoins all Local Government Units (LGUs) to fully support the implementation of E.O. No. 70, S-2018.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to condemn, as it does hereby strongly condemn, all forms of atrocities and acts of violence in support of Executive Order No. 70, S-2018.
