RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8193**, S-2020

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PROVIDE SHUTTLE OR TRANSPORT SERVICES TO THE EMPLOYEES OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT WHO WILL PHYSICALLY REPORT FOR WORK DURING THE PERIOD OF MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MECQ) OR GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ) UNDER ALTERNATIVE WORK ARRANGEMENTS.

WHEREAS, under the guidelines of the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases, in relation to Memorandum Circular No. 10, S-2020 of the Civil Service Commission, government agencies/offices, including the Local Government Units (LGUs), may resume its operations during the period of MECQ and GCQ subject to the limitation in its operational capacity and they have to adopt an Alternative Work Arrangements to continually observe social or physical distancing and other quarantine protocols in response to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, under the Alternative Work Arrangements, city government employees who will prefer Skeleton (Skeletal) Workforce, Four-day (Compressed) Work week or Staggered Working Hours as their work schedule will be required to physically report for work to man their respective offices;

WHEREAS, since public transportation will be allowed but in a reduced capacity during the period of MECQ and GCQ, the city government employees will have difficulty in going to and from their offices, especially those residing in far-reaching barangays and outside Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to ensure the convenience and safety of the said employees and to protect them from possible exposure to COVID-19, there is an imperative need to provide them with adequate, clean and sanitized shuttle or transport services.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to provide shuttle or transport services to the employees of the Quezon City Government who will physically report for work during the period of Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) or General Community Quarantine (GCQ) under Alternative Work Arrangements.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that for the effective and hazard-free use of the subject shuttle or transport services, the convenient route and pick-up points of employees shall be designated.


