WHEREAS, the World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC) alongside governments, health experts and other industry associations are working together to achieve effective recovery protocols by developing meaningful action plans that optimize sectorwide recovery efforts;

WHEREAS, the WTTC unveils "Safe Travels" new global protocols to restart the Travel and Tourism sector, the protocols have been designed to rebuild confidence among consumers so they can travel safely once the restrictions are lifted;

WHEREAS, the WTTC has launched a stamp that will allow travellers to identify governments and businesses around the world that have adopted the organization's health and hygiene standardized protocols;

WHEREAS, the companies eligible to receive the stamp include hotels, restaurants, airlines, cruise lines, tour operators, transportation services, outdoor shopping and airports. The new global safety stamp is designed to help rebuild consumer confidence worldwide;

WHEREAS, the travellers will be able to recognize the businesses and destinations worldwide that have adopted the new set of global protocols that will encourage the return of "Safe Travels" around the world. This will, in turn, help the travel and tourism sector reopen for business and move in a coordinated approach;

WHEREAS, the launch of global protocols to recover the Travel and Tourism sector have been embraced by over 200 CEO's including some of the world's major tourism groups. Ensuring safety and hygiene of travellers are the top priority;

WHEREAS, the attached protocol by the World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC) "Safe Travels" New Global Protocols for Travel and Tourism sector under the new normal, attached herein as Annex A, B and C be made an integral part of this Resolution.
