A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH BARANGAY TEACHER'S VILLAGE EAST, REPRESENTED BY ITS PUNONG BARANGAY LOLITA DL. SINGSON, FOR THE TURN-OVER OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS AND LIVELIHOOD BUILDING LOCATED ALONG C.P. GARCIA AVENUE OF BARANGAY TEACHER'S VILLAGE EAST WHICH SHALL BE USED AS THE QUEZON CITY MOLECULAR LABORATORY.

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2020 President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 "Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines" because of the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, on 13 March 2020, the Quezon City Council declared Quezon City to be under a State of Calamity due to the pandemic;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11469, otherwise known as the "Bayanihan to Heal as One Act", declared a State of National Emergency over the entire country;

WHEREAS, for purposes of appreciating the generosity of Barangay Teacher's Village East through its willingness to turn-over and relinquish its right to the Quezon City Government over the Senior Citizens Livelihood Building for purposes of establishing the first Quezon City Molecular Laboratory;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government will undertake to provide Barangay Teacher's Village East with a replacement building located at a site designated by Barangay Teacher's Village East;

WHEREAS, this is in appreciation of the wholehearted support given by Barangay Teacher's Village East in the establishment of the first Quezon City Molecular Laboratory which will benefit the residents of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 22 (c) and 455 (b)(1)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991, prior authorization by the Sangguniang Panlungsod is necessary before the City Mayor can enter into a contract.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with Barangay Teacher's Village East, represented by its Punong Barangay Lolita DL. Singson, for the turn-over of the Senior Citizens and Livelihood Building located along C.P. Garcia Avenue of Barangay Teacher's Village East which shall be used as the Quezon City Molecular Laboratory.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
