A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE PROFOUND CONDOLENCES AND SYMPATHIES TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE SENATOR RAMON REVILLA SR. AND HONORING HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PHILIPPINE SOCIO-CULTURAL AND POLITICAL DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, José Acuña Bautista Sr., popularly known as Ramon Revilla Sr. or simply Ramon Revilla (March 8, 1927 - June 26, 2020), is an actor and a politician. He graduated from Far Eastern University with a Bachelor Degree in Commerce, and was elected Senator from 1992 to 2004 and made his mark in legislation. He will most arguably be remembered as the silver screen legend "Hari ng Agimat". He died of heart failure at around 5:20 pm on Friday, 26 June 2020;

WHEREAS, Revilla patriarch was known for his lead roles in classic fantasy films such as "Nardong Putik", "Pepeng Agimat", "Tonyong Bayawak", and "Tiagong Akyat", among others, which showcased the Filipino's indomitable and resolute spirit that prevails over unconquerable hardship;

WHEREAS, in the course of his career in the movie industry, he has won numerous acting awards. Prior to joining showbiz, Senator Revilla Sr. worked in government as a Senior Intelligence Officer and later as Head of the Secret Service Unit (now the Customs Intelligence and Investigation Division) of the Bureau of Customs from 1965 to 1972;

WHEREAS, according to the Philippine Senate, Senator Revilla Sr. became known as the father of the "Public Works Act, a result of his being designated chairperson of the Senate Public Works Committee and his authorship of Republic Act No. 8150 which was signed into law by President Fidel V. Ramos on September 8, 1995";

WHEREAS, he also authored Republic Act No. 8294, also known as the "Revilla Law", which lowered the penalties imposed on illegal possession of firearms;

WHEREAS, the unselfish and dedicated service he had rendered to the public deserves the respect and gratitude of the people he had served faithfully and well.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, the profound condolences and sympathies to the bereaved family of the late Senator Ramon Revilla Sr., an institution not only in the Philippine movie industry but also in Public Service.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Council also honors the contributions of Senator Ramon Revilla Sr., a politician and standard bearer of the Lakas Political Party (LP), to the socio-cultural and political development of the country.






