RESOLUTION NO. SP- 8272, S-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ACCEPT THE DONATION FROM AYALA FOUNDATION, INC., REPRESENTED BY ITS ATTORNEY-IN-FACT, RUEL T. MARANAN AND CELERINA ASUNSION R. AMORES, AND TO EXECUTE THE RELATED DEED OF DONATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF ONE (1) UNIT OF PCR MACHINE WITH ACCESSORIES WORTH TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP2,700,000.00) FOR THE QUEZON CITY MOLECULAR LABORATORY, FOR PURPOSES OF COVID-19 TESTING.

WHEREAS, on 8 March 2020 President Rodrigo Roa Duterte declared a State of Public Health Emergency in the Philippines through Proclamation No. 922 to facilitate measures to address the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, on 13 March 2020, the Quezon City Council, in special session, adopted Resolution No. SP-8141, Series of 2020, which declared a State of Calamity in Quezon City due to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF) has recommended the extension of community quarantine in certain areas to contain and prevent the spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council has approved Ordinance No. SP-2937, S-2020 appropriating the donated amount to the Quezon City Trust Fund in the amount of Twenty-Six Million Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (Php26,999,700.00) to build, equip, and maintain the Quezon City Molecular Laboratory for purposes of Coronavirus Disease 2019 testing;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council has approved Resolution No. SP-8223, S-2020 authorizing the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with Barangay Teacher's Village East for the turn-over of the Senior Citizens and Livelihood Building located along C.P. Garcia Avenue, Barangay Teacher's Village East, which shall be used as the Quezon City Molecular Laboratory;

WHEREAS, Ayala Foundation, Inc. is a non-stock, non-profit corporation which develops, implements, and sustains programs in various fields of social and cultural development as the corporate social responsibility arm of Ayala Corporation;

WHEREAS, for purposes of improving the capabilities and facilities of the Quezon City Molecular Laboratory, Ayala Foundation, Inc. will be donating the following equipment and accessories worth Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php2,700,000.00):

- a. One (1) unit of Bio-Rad CFX96 Touch TM Real-Time PCR Detection System including C1000 Touch TM Thermal Cycler Chassis, CFX96 Optical Reaction Module, USB cable and instruction manual;
- b. One (1) unit of CFX Maestro TM Software for CFX Real-Time PCR Instruments;
- c. One (1) unit of computer;
- d. One (1) unit of printer;
- e. One (1) unit of uninterruptible power supply, 3KVA; and
- f. One (1) unit of automatic voltage regulator, 3 KVA

WHEREAS, the civic spirit and generosity of the officers and members of the Ayala Foundation, Inc. during this time of COVID-19 pandemic are greatly appreciated by the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bond, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.



NOW, THEREFORE,


