RESOLUTION NO. SP- 8274, S-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO PURCHASE TWO (2) UNITS OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP5,600,000.00) TO BE UTILIZED AS MOBILE TESTING FACILITY OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, on 8 March 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte declared a State of Public Health Emergency in the Philippines through Proclamation No. 922 to facilitate measures to address the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, on 13 March 2020, the Quezon City Council in special session adopted Resolution No. SP-8141, Series of 2020, which declared a State of Calamity in Quezon City due to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, at the exponential rate the virus is spreading and considering that Quezon City is the biggest city in Metro Manila with over three (3) million people in one hundred forty-two (142) barangays, there is an imperative need to purchase the subject vehicles to conduct mobile testing, which is vital to fast track efforts of the City Government in curbing the spread of COVID-19 through community-based testing, as well as to bring the City Government's services as close as possible to its inhabitants;
