A RESOLUTION GRANTING A MARKET FRANCHISE TO MR. MELQUIADES AYPA ROBLES FOR THE OPERATION OF JULIANA MARKET LOCATED AT NO. 1176 EPIFANIO DE LOS SANTOS AVENUE, BALINTAWAK, BARANGAY UNANG SIGAW, QUEZON CITY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH AND SUBJECT TO THE PERTINENT PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-2459, S-2015, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED QUEZON CITY MARKET CODE.

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015, otherwise known as the Revised Quezon City Market Code, was enacted by the Quezon City Council in order to integrate all laws and ordinances for more efficient and organized system of regulation of public markets and market-related activities to safeguard the interest of the consumers;

WHEREAS, it is the legislative intent of the Quezon City Council to require new and all existing private markets to secure market franchise from the Quezon City Council subject to renewal every after five (5) years;

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1, paragraph 1.4 of the Revised Quezon City Market Code, provides that no person, partnership or corporation shall operate a private market within Quezon City without first securing a franchise from the City Council. Paragraph 1.4.1 further provides that all franchise to operate granted to private markets shall be reapplied for renewal every five (5) years;

WHEREAS, the Juliana Market is a private market located at No. 1176 EDSA, Balintawak, Barangay Unang Sigaw, Quezon City operated by Mr. Melquiades Aypa Robles;

WHEREAS, Juliana Market has complied with all the documents necessary for the renewal of its franchise to operate a private market pursuant to City Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015;

WHEREAS, the franchise granted, being a mere privilege, may be withdrawn at any time by the City Government and subject to regulation, control and limitation of the provisions of the Revised Quezon City Market Code, Quezon City Revenue Code and other applicable laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, non-fulfillment of the conditions of the franchise granted and continuing violation of the Revised Quezon City Market Code, Quezon City Revenue Code and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be grounds for the revocation or withdrawal of the franchise, after observance of due process.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, a market franchise to Mr. Melquiades Aypa Robles for the operation of Juliana Market located at No. 1176 Epifanio De Los Santos Avenue, Balintawak, Barangay Unang Sigaw, Quezon City, in accordance with and subject to the pertinent provisions of Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015, otherwise known as the Revised Quezon City Market Code.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the market franchise granted under this Resolution shall be for a period of five (5) years and subject to the payment of franchise fee and annual franchise tax provided under Article III, Section 1, paragraph 1.4.3 of the Revised Quezon City Market Code.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that in case the Juliana Market sells and/or transfers the ownership thereof to any person or entity, the new owner shall secure a new market franchise from the Quezon City Council.
