A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH ATTY. ARISTOTLE O. LIWAG, TO USE AND UTILIZE A PARCEL OF LAND, COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NO. 004-2019004672 OF THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS OF QUEZON CITY, CONTAINING AN AREA OF TWO THOUSAND (2000) SQUARE METERS, LOCATED AT BARANGAY TANDANG SORA, QUEZON CITY, AS MODEL PILOT URBAN FARM IN SUPPORT OF THE FOOD SECURITY PROGRAM OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

*WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Government's Food Security Program, City Mayor Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte signed Executive Order No. 32, Series of 2020 on 19 May 2020 creating the Task Force on Food Security;*

*WHEREAS, the QC Food Security Task Force has established a 7-point action plan and the Grow QC-Kasama ka sa Pag-Unlad sa Pagkain, Kabuhayan at Kalusugan Food Security Initiative to address hunger, loss of livelihood and better health as a recovery response to the pandemic;*

*WHEREAS, in realizing this plan, the City Government seeks to collaborate with the organizations, cause oriented groups, advocates of natural/organic and sustainable agriculture, scientists and technologists, organized groups in communities, and to tap the expertise and experiences of natural/organic and sustainable urban agriculture practitioners, to share new technologies and practices towards attaining food sufficiency;*

*WHEREAS, Atty. Aristotle O. Liwag is the registered owner of a parcel of land covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. 004-2019004672 of the Registry of Deeds of Quezon City, containing an area of two thousand (2000) square meters located at Barangay Pasong Tamo, Quezon City, technically described as Lot 777-A-3-B-1-D-4, PSD-00-081539;*

*WHEREAS, the owner supports and advocates for the promotion, implementation and development of natural/organic agriculture, urban farming, environmental protection and livelihood generation for the underprivileged, and is interested to enter into a partnership with the City Government for the implementation of the latter's Food Security Program;*

*WHEREAS, the owner allows the City Government to use and utilize the vacant lot as a model pilot urban farm and as a place for seedling, vermiculture or organic fertilizer production, and other similar endeavors; and as a place for learning and training for a period of three (3) years;*

*WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.*




