A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ACCEPT THE DONATION FROM THE GOKONGWEI BROTHERS FOUNDATION AND TO EXECUTE THE RELATED DEED OF DONATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF SIXTY-FIVE (65) COMPUTER UNITS (LAPTOPS) FOR PURPOSES OF AIDING INSTITUTIONS, HEALTH WORKERS, AND OTHER AGENCIES AND PERSONNEL INVOLVED IN THE FIGHT AGAINST COVID-19.

WHEREAS, on 8 March 2020, President Rodrigo Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines to address the rising cases of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, on 13 March 2020, the Quezon City Council, in a special session adopted Resolution No. SP-8141, S-7020, which declared a State of Calamity in Quezon City due to COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, on 16 March 2020, President Duterte declared an Enhanced Community Quarantine over the entire mainland Luzon to curb the spread of COVID-19, which imposed strict home quarantine, closed down non-essential businesses, and restricted mobility, among others;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID) subsequently recommended the extension of community quarantine in the country due to the growing number of COVID-19 cases in and out of Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, for purposes of aiding all institutions, health workers, and other agencies and personnel involved in the fight against COVID-19 within Quezon City, the Gokongwei Brothers Foundation will be donating sixty-five (65) computer units (laptops) with an estimated value of Two Million Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (Php2,280,000.00) to the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, the civic spirit and generosity of the Gokongwei Brothers Foundation during this time of the COVID-19 pandemic are greatly appreciated by the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to accept the donation from the Gokongwei Brothers Foundation and to execute the related Deed of Donation and Acceptance of sixty-five (65) computer units (laptops) for purposes of aiding institutions, health workers, and other agencies and personnel involved in the fight against COVID-19.
