BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN CRITICAL PATIENT CARE AND LIFE OPTIONS (CPCLO) RESPIRATORY AND EQUIPMENT SERVICES RELATIVE TO AN OFFICE SPACE AT QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL FOR RESPIRATORY CARE AND TREATMENT OF QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL PATIENTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH), the Quezon City Government's main health resource for specialized and sophisticated hospital services, endeavors to provide respiratory and equipment service to reduce morbidity and mortality rates caused by acute and chronic diseases of the lung that require pulmonary treatment;

WHEREAS, the Critical Patient Care and Life Options (CPCLO) Respiratory and Equipment Services warrants that it is licensed and authorized by existing laws, rules and regulations, both local and national, to provide high-class respiratory care and treatment within the Philippines and that it will continuously operate modern respiratory machines and shall employ only qualified health professionals to provide such services, strictly in accordance with the qualifications and standards required by QCGH.

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
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with Critical Patient Care and Life Options (CPCLO) Respiratory and Equipment Services relative to an office space at Quezon City General Hospital for respiratory care and treatment of Quezon City General Hospital patients.


