RESOLUTION NO. SP-8425, S-2020

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE APPLICATION FOR MARKET FRANCHISE OF SABINA MARKET, INC., FOR THE OPERATION OF A MARKET LOCATED AT J.P. RAMOY STREET, CORNER QUIRINO HI-WAY, BARANGAY TALIPAPA, DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH AND SUBJECT TO THE PERTINENT PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-2459, S-2015, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED QUEZON CITY MARKET CODE.

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015, otherwise known as the Revised Quezon City Market Code, was enacted by the Quezon City Council in order to integrate all laws and ordinances for more efficient and organized system of regulation of public markets and market-related activities to safeguard the interest of the consumers;

WHEREAS, it is the legislative intent of the Quezon City Council to require new and all existing private markets to secure market franchise from the Ouezon City Council, subject to renewal every five (5) years;

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1, Paragraph 1.4 of the Revised Quezon City Market Code, provides that no person, partnership or corporation shall operate a private market within Quezon City without first securing a franchise from the City Council. Paragraph 1.4.1 further provides that all franchise to operate granted to private markets shall be reapplied for renewal every five (5) years;

WHEREAS, the Sabina Market, Inc. is a Wet and Dry Market located at J.P. Ramoy Street, corner Quirino Hi-way, Barangay Talipapa, District VI, Quezon City, operated by Olympia C. Del Rosario. It has been issued a franchise under Ordinance No. SP-1963, S-2009 which is now for renewal before the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, the Sabina Market, Inc. has complied with all the documents necessary for the renewal of its franchise to operate a private market pursuant to City Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015;

WHEREAS, the franchise granted, being a mere privilege, may be withdrawn at anytime by the City Government and subject to regulation, control and limitation of the provisions of the Revised Quezon City Market Code, Quezon City Revenue Code and other applicable laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, non-fulfillment of the conditions of the franchise herein granted and the continuing violation of the Revised Quezon City Market Code, Quezon City Revenue Code and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be grounds for the revocation or withdrawal of the franchise, after observance of due process.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, a market franchise to Sabina Market Inc., for the operation of a market located at J.P. Ramoy Street corner Quirino Hi-Way, Barangay Talipapa, District VI, Quezon City, in accordance with and subject to the pertinent provision of Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015, otherwise known as the Revised Quezon City Market Code.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the market franchise granted under this Resolution shall be for a period of five (5) years and subject to the payment of franchise fee and annual franchise tax provided under Article III, Section 1, Paragraph 1.4.3 of the Revised Quezon City Market Code.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that in case the Sabina Market, Inc., sells and/or transfers the ownership of the CI Market to any person or entity, the new owner shall secure a new market franchise from the Quezon City Council.
