RESOLUTION NO. SP- 8427 , S-2020

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RENEWAL OF A SPECIAL PERMIT TO TOTAL GAMEZONE XTREME, INCORPORATED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED AT 2/F MSK BUILDING, 241 VISAYAS AVENUE, TANDANG SORA, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines located at 2/F MSK Building, No. 241 Visayas Avenue, Tandang Sora, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the City Council for the operation of the same business;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew their Special Permit by the City Council for the operation of the same business;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP 2285, S-2014, in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated is earnestly requesting the City Council to grant the renewal of a Special Permit to operate an E-Games establishment;

WHEREAS, the operation of E-Games is regulated and licensed by the PAGCOR;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government, thereby boosting the city's economy.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, the renewal of a Special Permit to Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated to operate an E-Games establishment at 2/F MSK Building, No. 241 Visayas Avenue, Tandang Sora, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the PAGCOR.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasury during the lifetime of this measure.
