


WHEREAS, on March 24, 2015, PGen. Macerin was a recipient of Medalya ng Kasanayan (Efficiency Medal) for his exceptional, meritorious and invaluable service for fretting out the Mamasapano debacle. He also received the Medalya ng Kagalingan (PNP Merit Medal) for the successful arrest of a principal suspect in a carnapping, robbery/hold up and rape cases on October 5, 2020;




