A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A JOINT VENTURE AGREEMENT WITH QPAX TRAFFIC SYSTEMS, INCORPORATED, REPRESENTED BY ITS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, MANOLO STEVEN M. ONA, TO UNDERTAKE THE NO CONTACT APPREHENSION PROGRAM OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2336, Series of 2014 or the Quezon City PPP Code was enacted consistent with the City Government's policy of advancing the public good and general welfare, and promoting the interest of the community and the City within the framework of sustainable and integrated development, and effective constructive engagement and meaningful people's participation in local governance;

WHEREAS, the present system of apprehending traffic violators sometimes causes traffic build up, which aggravates the traffic situation in the City;

WHEREAS, to provide better services to the motorists and the riding public, there is a need to introduce technology to further improve traffic management in the City;

WHEREAS, QPAX Traffic Systems, Incorporated, represented by its Chief Executive Officer, Manolo Steven M. Ona, is a corporation duly organized and existing under Philippine laws, with principal place of business at Suite 304 State Condominium One, No. 186 Salcedo Street, Legaspi Village, Makati City. QPAX Traffic Systems, Incorporated has knowledge of and licenses for certain specialized equipment, applications and Notice of Violation processes related to no contact apprehension cameras;

WHEREAS, to improve traffic management and to enhance the culture of traffic discipline among its motorists, the City Government shall implement a No Contact Apprehension Program, which shall provide an alternative method of enforcing traffic rules and regulations by operating a 24-hour no contact apprehension system to aid in instilling a round-the-clock compliance to the said rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Joint Venture Agreement with QPAX Traffic Systems, Incorporated, represented by its Chief Executive Officer, Manolo Steven M. Ona, to undertake the No Contact Apprehension Program of Quezon City.
