A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT GRANTED TO BPC MANAGEMENT GROUP, INC. TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC BINGO ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED AT NO. 1 KAMIAS ROAD, BARANGAY PINYAHAN, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, BPC Management Group, Inc. is a domestic business entity duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines located at No. 1 Kamias Road, Barangay Pinyahan, District IV, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to operate a Bingo establishment in Quezon City, there is a need to secure a Special Permit from the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014, in relation to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, BPC Management Group, Inc. is earnestly requesting the City Council to grant a Special Permit to operate an Electronic Bingo establishment;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government, thereby boosting the city's economy.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit granted to BPC Management Group, Inc. to operate an Electronic Bingo establishment located at No. 1 Kamias Road, Barangay Pinyahan, District IV, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).


RESOLVED FURTHER, that BPC Management Group, Inc. shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the said office during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the authority herein granted shall be for a period of two (2) years and may be renewed by the City Council.
