RESOLUTION NO. SP- **8507**, S-2021

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF BELAGGIO AMUSEMENT GAMES AND ARCADE PARK CORPORATION TO OPERATE ELECTRONIC GAMES AT THE GROUND FLOOR, FISHERMALL, QUEZON AVENUE CORNER ROOSEVELT AVENUE, BARANGAY STA. CRUZ, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, *Bellagio Amusement Games and Arcade Park Corporation* is a corporation formed and registered under Philippine laws located at the Ground Floor, Fishermall, Quezon Avenue corner Roosevelt Avenue, Barangay Sta. Cruz, District I, Quezon City, and is applying for the renewal of its Special Permit to operate Electronic Games;

WHEREAS, sometime in 2019, the City Council passed a Resolution granting a Special Permit to the applicant to operate the said Electronic Games docketed as Resolution No. SP-7792, S-2019;

WHEREAS, to enable *Bellagio Amusement Games and Arcade Park Corporation* to continue its legal business operation, there is a need to renew the said Special Permit;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in relation to existing City Ordinances, authorizes the City Council to grant special permit to business activity of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of *Bellagio Amusement Games and Arcade Park Corporation* to operate electronic games at the Ground Floor, Fishermall, Quezon Avenue corner Roosevelt Avenue, Barangay Sta. Cruz, District I, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate Electronic Games granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The holding of Electronic Games shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;*
- b. The operation of Electronic Games shall not include the playing of games not related to or other than Electronic Games;*
- c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age from playing in the abovementioned games.*

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that Bellagio Amusement Games and Arcade Park Corporation shall remit to the City Treasurer's Office a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the same office during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this Special Permit to operate Electronic Games shall be for a period of two (2) years and may be renewed by the City Council.
