RESOLUTION NO. SP-8510, S-2021

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RENEWAL OF SPECIAL PERMIT TO BIGGAME, INC. TO OPERATE ELECTRONIC GAMING STATIONS AND OTHER GAMING ACTIVITIES AT SIR WILLIAMS HOTEL, NO. 39 TIMOG AVENUE, BARANGAY SOUTH TRIANGLE, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR).

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the City Council for the operation of the same business;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to the existing city ordinance;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in relation to existing city ordinances, authorizes the City Council to grant or renew a special permit to business activity of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit to Biggame, Inc. to operate Electronic Gaming Stations and other gaming activities at Sir Williams Hotel, No. 39 Timog Avenue, Barangay South Triangle, District IV, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate Electronic Gaming Stations and other gaming activities granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. The holding of Electronic Gaming Stations and other gaming activities shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
- b. The operation of Electronic Gaming Stations and other gaming activities shall not include the playing of games not related to it;
- c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age from playing in the abovementioned games.
