RESOLUTION NO. SP. 8533, S-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT FOR THE INSTALLATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HUMAN RESOURCE INFORMATION SYSTEM (HRIS), EPAYROLL SYSTEM (ePS) AND ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE MONITORING SYSTEM FOR THE USE BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, upon the request by the Quezon City Government, the Commission on Audit (COA), through its Information Technology Office (ITO), customized and delivered in August 2003 the three application systems, namely, (a) Personnel Management Information System (PMIS), (b) Payroll Information System (PIS) and (c) Attendance and Leave Monitoring System (ALeMS);

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WHEREAS, from August 2003 up to present or for almost eighteen (18) years, the City Government utilizes the PMIS and PIS in the maintenance of database of personnel related data and in the processing of payroll of Quezon City Government employees;

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2019, the City Government sought the assistance of the COA in the upgrading and enhancement of PMIS, PIS, ALeMS to cope with the changes and increasing requirements in maintaining personnel data and processing of payroll;

WHEREAS, the COA informed the City Government that the systems can no longer be upgraded or enhanced as the programming tool in the development of systems has reached its End-of-Life support, thus, PMIS, PIS, ALeMS were already upgraded into a web-based application systems currently being used by COA;

WHEREAS, the City Government requested for the availment of the newly developed systems currently being used by COA such as the Human Resource Information System (HRIS) and the ePayroll System (ePS);

WHEREAS, in the Memorandum of Agreement, COA shall install the HRIS and ePS application software to the City Government and provide technical assistance in operating the same, while the City shall provide the servers, computers, and necessary facilities for the successful installation and operation of the systems;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Commission on Audit for the installation and implementation of the Human Resource Information System (HRIS), ePayroll System (ePS), and Attendance and Leave Monitoring System for the use by the Quezon City Government.

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RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the subject Memorandum of Agreement shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
