*WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code 1991, mandates every local government unit to promote the general welfare of its constituents by enhancing their right to a balanced ecology;*

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources-National Capital Region (DENR-NCR) is mandated to implement the National Greening Program (NGP) pursuant to Executive Order No. 26, Series of 2011, which includes urban areas under the greening plan of local government units as one of the priority sites for planting;

WHEREAS, DENR-NCR partnered with the Quezon City Government in crafting the Climate Resilient and Localized Urban Greening Plan (CRLUGP) for Quezon City, which is a Geographic Information System (GIS)-based plan that aims to provide a visual tool for LGUs in enhancing their greening and other environmental activities;

WHEREAS, CRLUGP contains the location of suitable sites for planting various indigenous forest tree species and fruit-bearing trees in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, during the COVID-19 pandemic, adoption of the CRLUGP is timely as a means of strengthening the implementation of the NGP and enhancing food security;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act. No. 7160, the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department OF Environment and Natural Resources-National Capital Region (DENR-NCR) for the implementation of the Climate Resilient and Localized Urban Greening Plan (CRLUGP) for Quezon City.
